The year has just flown by and I find myself writing this final newsletter with mixed emotions. It has been a pleasure teaching Green Group this year. We have had a very productive final term, particularly with the implementation of our sports program 'Playball'. The children responded well to Victor building a rapport with him early in the term. The program focused on building skills in cooperation, teamwork and listening skills through a range of ball sports. Each session we focused on a different sport, including baseball, football, soccer and tennis.

The last few sessions were themed around Christmas. The three-year-olds were busy making Christmas gifts for their families, singing Christmas songs and reading Christmas stories. To celebrate the last session for the year we offered additional open-ended Christmas craft, Christmas puzzles and a small-world table where children could create their own Christmas stories.
